We have long tried to keep Atbin a nice, welcoming, warm & cozy place for our supporting audiences, trusting customers, collectors and artist friends.






## Bavan Gallery




# Bostan Art Gallery

## Project Statement

This collection brings together works by three artists, each of whom engages directly with dynamics of Tehran. Setareh Azmoudeh reinterprets urban density and structure, reflecting city forms in her works; Nooshin Shafiee captures rhythm and everyday life through her personal perspective and recording of its hideen moments; and Nazgol Ansarinia, through rearrangement and reconstruction of architectural elements and urban components, makes rapid changes and tension between memory and spatial instability tangible in her work.

Placement of these works, each shaped by a direct and close interaction with Tehran, in a space overlooking the city, may provide the conditions for a dialogue between city, the artworks, and audience experience.





IN/JA is a space for encountering art, where works shaped by time, society, and the world are presented independently of the artist's background. The gallery hosts both group and solo exhibitions. Group shows bring together works from different generations around a shared theme, while solo exhibitions highlight emerging artists. The gallery's focus is contemporary Iranian art, particularly works inspired by Persian miniature and still-life traditions.

IN/JA's first location was a historic house in Neauphle-le-Château, followed by a period of activity on Mirzaye Shirazi Street. Continuing its path, IN/JA has now resumed its work in a new space on Enghelab Street under the direction of Saber Abar. After a temporary pause due to social circumstances, the gallery reopened in October 2025 with an exhibition of works by Parvaneh Etemadi, marking a renewed step in artistic dialogue.


